ADDITIONAL COSTS

External and international examinations, checkpoints, textbooks, coursework components related to Cambridge & Sí, remedial specialists, facilitators, invigilators, technology devices, calculators, elective extra-mural activities, matric jacket & dance, camps, workshops, career advisement assessments, bus transport, boarding (if applicable), uniforms, early care, lunch, afternoon snack, aftercare, holiday care and swimming academy.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- · Lunch is optional in all Phases. Please refer to welcome pack and/or family charter for further information relating to our food policy
- Special Dietary Requirements for Morning Snack and/or Lunch and/or Afternoon Snack is an additional fee per month i.e. vegetarian, vegan, gluten-free or dairy-free.
- Áftercare and holiday care is optional in all Phases. If you do not select the lunch option, please ensure you provide your child/ren with adequate food to last the school day, including aftercare and holiday care.
- Aftercare does not include holiday care. This is an additional cost
- Students collected after the finishing time will incur a fine of R100 per 15 minutes or part thereof.
- The holiday care service can be selected without taking lunch or aftercare, in which case the published holiday care fee should be paid with monthly education fees, otherwise ad hoc rates will be billed.
- Please note that if monthly holiday care is not selected and paid from January to December, ad hoc rates will be applicable.
- · Early morning care is billed irrespective of the amount of days attended in a particular month.
- No early care is offered during holidays. Holiday care closing time is 17h00 (not 17h30).
- Lower Secondary refers to Stage 7 & 8 in the Cambridge pathway (2 years), which is the 12-15 Phase.
- IGCSE & AS Levels refer to International General Certificate of Secondary Education 1, 2, Advanced Subsidiary 1 & 2 in the Cambridge pathway (4 years), which is the 15-18 Phase. If a student commences IGCSE's, regardless of age, will be included in the 15-18 Phase for academic and billing purposes.
- IAQ's relate to the International Access Qualifications offered in the Si pathway, which is tailored to a students' needs.
- Si campus-based students are based at the designated campus for most of their schooling. Si part-time students will perform and complete
 the majority of their studies off-campus i.e. home and will have specific dates within a semester that are pre-arranged where a student will come
 to campus for facilitation. Si distance-based students will perform and complete all of their studies off-campus i.e. home with no on-campus
 facilitation time.
- Cambridge & Sí Exits are separately billable programmes. Should a student be on both programmes, both programme costs will be applicable and pro-rated as the case may be.
- Sí costs relate to 120 credit programmes. Programme costs will be pro-rated where programmes are less than 120 credits e.g. 60 credits.
- Annual levies are payable in advance and are to be received on or before the 1st of January.
- The resource asset levy is no longer subject-specific as these costs will be billed in the relevant Cambridge exam sitting to ensure fair and commensurate billings based on your child/ren's subject choices.
- Early payment discounts are only applicable if the annual school fees (less applicable discount) reflect in Generation Schools' bank account on or before the mentioned dates.
- If you do not pay education fees annually in advance, you will be required to pay via debit order.
- School fees are payable over 12 months via debit order, in advance, and are to be received on or before the 1st of each month.

- Final year 15-18 Phase students (Cambridge & Sí) are billed the annual school fees over 10 months, not 12.
- Fees received after the 1st of each month will be subject to a late payment fee of R500 per month and interest on outstanding balances will
 be charged at Prime + 2%, per month. Should fees be outstanding in full or part for one or more months the child/children may be
 suspended from school. Should fees be outstanding in full or part for two or more months the outstanding account may be handed over
 to debt recovery attorneys.
- Payments to the school are required to be gross of payment gateway transaction costs. Should a debit order be rejected due to insufficient funds or other reasons, the guardians will be liable for associated transaction charges.
- All quoted fees exclude early payment discounts and sibling discounts.
- · All queries to be directed to the finance department (either your financial administrator and/or accounts@generationschools.co.za).
- One school term's notice (3 months), in writing, is required before removing your child/ren from the school, or payment in lieu thereof will be required.
- Billing options can be amended on the GenEx Parent Portal. Note that one calendar month notice is required for changes to be effective e.g. Lunch to be stopped.
- Education fees relate to the cost of the programme for an academic year (Montessori, Cambridge & Si), billed over a calendar year.
 Programme fees are not discounted/rebated further if a student completes their studies earlier in the academic year. If a student prolongs their programme beyond an academic year (12 months, usually a calendar year) then the following year annual programme cost will be charged monthly, over and above the current annual programme cost associated with a 12 month period, until the student completes their submission/exam.
- Generation Schools is a cash free zone, parents are kindly requested not to pay in this manner. We reserve the right to recover cash deposit fees incurred.
- Please quote your 'Child Name & Surname' with your payments.
- Foreign exchange students are required to pay all relevant fees termly in advance, including the registration and placement fees.
- The bus transport and Cambridge exam fee structures are published separately.
- All students from 12-Exit Phases will be required to purchase a device or bring their own device. Regardless of which option is chosen the
 device's administration rights are required to be signed over to the school for management purposes. Devices are brought to school at own
 risk. Device specifications will be provided.
- Sports, Arts, Cultural and Extra-Mural Activities may only be offered to certain phases- please inquire from the school for further information.
- Elective extra-murals, swimming academy, school photographs and workshops are separately payable activities which will be facilitated via
 the Karri app, during the academic year.
- Please inquire from the campus as to the finishing time(s) of a particular phase(s)
