TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Private Candidates are charged an admin fee to cover their registration with Cambridge International.
2. Generation Candidates requiring a separate venue due to special access arrangements and/or invigilator and/or reader and/or scribe will incur an additional cost, charged per paper.
3. If specialist access arrangements are requested for which Cambridge International approval is required, this is by arrangement only and is dependent on our capacity. Please contact us directly by the stipulated deadline. Additional invigilation and arrangement costs may be incurred for Generation Candidates. Generation Schools are not able to accommodate specialist access arrangements for Private Candidates, apart from extra-time.
4. Charged per practical, per subject.
5. Sciences include separately billable subjects, papers relating to the following:
 - Physical Sciences [IGCSE]
 - Chemistry [IGCSE and AS/A Level]
 - Physics [IGCSE and AS/A Level]
 - Biology [IGCSE and AS/A Level]For the avoidance of any doubt, the Science Levy is charged separately for:
1x Sciences Levy for Physical Science and/or Chemistry and/or Physics, and
1x Sciences Levy for Biology"
6. Charged per candidate, per subject.
7. After the final entry closing date, we will charge late fees for any new entries you make, as well as for any entry amendments or syllabus changes. Entries or changes received after the published deadlines can cause disruption to carefully scheduled processes and cause significant additional work. Late entry fees are therefore applied to recover the costs of additional processing requirements, and to encourage the submission of entries by the advertised closing dates. Late entry fees will be charged in addition to the normal syllabus fee. Cambridge International may be unable to accept entry changes in the very late entries period if these are received too close to the exam.
8. Courier costs relating to the sending/return of art are based on items being returned by courier and on work being a maximum size of A2. There may be an additional postage charge if the maximum size/weight is exceeded.
9. A quote relating to your child/ren's estimated Cambridge International examination fees will be sent at the beginning of the school year for payment, for Generation Candidates. Please note that this is only an estimate and may not be the final examination costs due to various changes that may occur during the academic year, e.g. subject changes. It is encouraged that this quote is paid as early as possible to avoid financial pressure prior to the final submission date to Cambridge International.
10. An invoice for entry will be emailed to you for careful checking. Please notify us via email of necessary amendments immediately on receipt of the invoice. We cannot be held responsible for entry errors that should have been identified by you. Errors requiring amendment which are identified after the schools Cambridge International submission date will incur the late penalty fee so please inform us before that date.
11. All quotes given will be subject to fluctuations in the foreign exchange rate. Due to the nature of the Pound:Rand exchange rate, an adjustment may be required during the year, in which case an extra invoice may be sent to candidates.
12. Date for full payment of the examination fees into the Generation Schools' bank account (same as school fees) will fall due and payable on the invoice date.
13. Examination fees to be paid into the same bank account of the school/campus that the candidate attends, using the same reference assigned for school fees i.e. 'Student Name & Surname'.
14. Private Candidates are to pay their examination fees into the bank account of the campus at which they will be writing. Please use your 'Student Name & Surname' as the reference.
15. Examination fees to be paid in advance of Generation Schools' submission of entries to Cambridge International.
16. In the event that examination fees are not paid in time to Generation Schools based on the published submission date, the prospective candidate will not be registered for their relevant examination entries.
17. Where prospective candidates have outstanding fees on their school account, any monies paid towards examination fees will be utilised against outstanding school fees first.
18. We only refund fees if you let us know about the withdrawal of a candidate before the published entry closing date. We issue refunds after the end of the examination series.
19. If a student is withdrawn from examinations before the ordinary late entry due date, a basic admin fee of R350 per subject will be retained, to cover our processing costs.
20. If a student is withdrawn from examinations after the ordinary late entry due date, the basic admin fee of R350 per subject PLUS 100% of all other admin fees will be retained.
21. Examination fees for Generation Candidates and Private Candidates are valid between January 2023 to December 2023.
22. Please refer to the Cambridge International subject offerings list for the subjects that are offered, per level, by Generation Schools as exam opportunities.
23. Examinations requiring computer devices, not limited to Computer Science and/or ICT, require the student to have access to their own device to be able to prepare and practise for the specific examination as well as complete the examination.
24. If a candidate makes use of a reader, scribe or similar, it is the candidate's responsibility to source it themselves. The school is not responsible to provide such services. This also applies to software used for access arrangements.
25. Private Candidates will not be able to enrol for any subjects that have coursework components, e.g. Art & Design and Drama.
