INFORMATION

- Age represents the age a student turns in the 2025 calendar year.
- Lunch is obligatory in the 9-18 Phases.
- Special Dietary Requirements for Morning Snack and/or Lunch and/or Afternoon Snack is an additional fee per month i.e. vegan, gluten-free, dairy-free or vegetarian, regardless of which billing option is chosen.
- No early care is offered during holidays. Holiday care closing time is 17h00.
- Aftercare cannot be selected without selecting the lunch option.
- Aftercare does not include holiday care. This is an additional cost.
- The holiday care service can be selected without taking lunch or aftercare, in which case the published holiday care fee should be paid with monthly education fees, otherwise ad hoc rates will be billed.
- Please note that if monthly holiday care is not selected and paid from January, ad hoc rates will be applicable.
- Middle School refers to Stage 7 & 8 or Lower Secondary 1 & 2 in the Cambridge pathway (2 years), which is the 12-15 Phase.
- The IGCSE, AS Levels and A Levels refers to the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) 1 & 2, Advanced Subsidiary (AS) 1 & 2 and Advanced Levels in the Cambridge pathway (4 years), which is the 15-18 Phase. If a student commences IGCSE's, regardless of age, will be included in the 15-18 Phase for academic and billing purposes.
- IAQs (International Access Qualifications) is a unique pathway exit offered to students as a powerful alternative to Cambridge/Matric equivalent.
- Cambridge & IAQ Exits are separately billable programmes. Should a student be on both programmes, both programme costs would be applicable and pro-rated as the case may be.
- School fees are payable over 12 months via debit order, in advance, and are to be received on or before the 1st of each month.
- Final year 15-18 Phase students (AS/A Level students) are billed the annual school fees over 10 months, not 12.
- A Levels are only offered on merit and demand.
- Three debit order dates will be available to parents/guardians to pay for school fees in advance, specifically the 15th, 25th and 1st.
- If you do not pay fees annually in advance, you will be required to pay via debit order.
- Payments to the school are required to be gross of transaction costs. Should a debit order be rejected due to insufficient funds or other reasons, the guardians will be liable for associated transaction charges.
- Fees received after the 1st of each month will be subject to a late payment fee of R550 per month and interest on outstanding balances will be charged at Prime + 2%, per month.
- Should any fees be outstanding in full or part for one or more months, the school will apply its formal debt recovery procedures. Should internal debt management processes be unsuccessful, and in the event of persistent non-payment, the school will instruct its debt collection attorneys to institute legal recovery proceedings. Such non-payment will also constitute a material breach of the school's terms and conditions, which may result in suspension and/or termination of enrolment.
- If any educational fees are outstanding- optional services such as aftercare and lunch as well as school sport, matches, camps, etc. may be ceased.
- Annual levies are payable in advance and are to be received on or before the 1st of January.
- Education fees relate to the cost of the programme for an academic year (Montessori, Cambridge & IAQ), billed over a calendar year. Programme fees are not discounted/rebated further if a student completes their studies earlier in the academic year. If a student prolongs their programme beyond an academic year (12 months, usually a calendar year) then the following year annual programme cost will be charged monthly, over and above the current annual programme cost associated with a 12 month period, until the student completes their submission/exam.
- Generation Schools is a cash free zone, parents/guardians are kindly requested not to pay in this manner. We reserve the right to recover cash deposit fees incurred.
- Students collected after the finishing time will incur a fee of R150 per 15 minutes or part thereof.
- Early payment discounts are only applicable if the annual school fees (less applicable discount) reflect in Generation Schools' bank account on or before the mentioned dates.
- All quoted fees exclude early payment discounts. No sibling discounts are applicable.
- All queries to be directed to the finance department (either your financial administrator and/or accounts@generationschools.co.za)
- Owing to inter alia the existence of natural breakpoints in the academic calendar, resource and capacity planning in education services, and the difficulties in filling suddenly-vacant spaces during the year, one term's written notice is required if you decide to withdraw your child(ren) from school. Should you wish to withdraw your child from school on shorter notice for any reason whatsoever, you hereby accept that you will remain liable for the same fees in lieu of notice required but not given, and which you accept to be a reasonable cancellation penalty, alternatively early cancellation fee.
- Billing options can be amended on the GenEx Portal. Note that one calendar month notice is required for changes e.g. Full day to half day.
- Please quote your 'Child Name & Surname' with your payments.
- Foreign exchange students are required to pay all relevant fees termly in advance, including the registration and placement fees.
- The Cambridge exam fee structure is published separately.
- All students from 12-18 Phases are required to bring your own devices ('BYOD' Policy). All student devices brought onto campus must have administration rights signed over to the school for management purposes.
- Sports, Arts, Cultural and Extra-Mural Activities may only be offered to certain phases- please inquire from the school for further information.
- Elective Extra-Mural activities, school photographs and workshops are separately payable activities which will be facilitated via the Karri app, during the academic year.
- IAQ Full-Time students are based at the designated campus for most of their schooling. IAQ Part-Time students will perform and complete the majority of their studies off-campus i.e. home and will have specific dates within a semester that are pre-arranged where a student will come to campus for facilitation. IAQ Distance students will perform and complete all of their studies off-campus i.e. home with no on-campus facilitation time.
- The monthly fee for IAQ courses must be paid in full for 12 months before a certificate can be issued to the student, unless the student completes their level sooner than the 12 months and continues studying with us for the next level. In this case only, the school will bill for the new course and not the completed course. The student will no longer be liable for the remaining fees for the completed course. A student is considered to have completed a course once all required work has been submitted to the qualifying body for certification. Completion does not occur at the end of teaching or the last day of class but is contingent on the submission of all assessments to the qualifying body. Should a student take longer than 12 months to complete the course, the monthly IAQ fee per the relevant year's fee structure will continue to be charged until the student's final result has been released.
- The International Access Qualification (IAQ) fees will increase by 7% for existing IAQ cohorts that commenced before 1 January 2025 (e.g., in the 2024 calendar year).
- New 2025 IAQ cohorts (e.g., commencing after 1 January 2025) will be charged according to the 2025 Fee Structure.
- No failure, delay, relaxation or indulgence on the part of the school in exercising any power or right conferred on it shall operate as a waiver of such right.
